We understand that you have launched another effort to thwart the plans of the UPCRC to provide a new support facility for the sport of rowing. We also understand the drawings that Sanders & Czapski Associates prepared for the UPCRC as part of their planning process are part of the public record and that you have a right to acquire them through the Freedom of Information Act. However, Sanders & Czapski Associates wants to go on record as objecting to the way you have used our drawings to portray the project. Your narrative includes none of the detail and planning that would accurately describe the project. We request that you remove our drawings from your web site immediately.


